Ride for the Alive 2017

08:00 – 10:00 Registration at American Legion Post 10, 1215 Pacific Blvd SE, Albany OR 97321.

10:00 KSU – head W on Pacific Blvd to OR-34.

Come out of the driveway and turn left on Sherman St to Pacific Blvd SE to SW Queen Ave. Turn right on Queen and continue onto Riverside Dr. Continue straight onto Oakville Rd SW. At OR-34 turn right. Stay in the left 2 lanes to turn left onto OR-34 Bypass W. Continue onto US-20W through Philomath. Stay left onto OR-34 as you leave Philomath.

Head W on OR-34 to Alsea. There will be a short stop in Alsea for rest and fuel, if needed. If you choose not to fuel up in Alsea, advise the road captain if you need to stop in Waldport.

Resume on OR-34 to Waldport. At Waldport we will proceed N on US-101 to Newport. In Newport, we take a left on Olive St. to American Legion Post 116, 424 W Olive St, Newport, OR 97365. We will stop for lunch and rest for approx. one hour.

Resume E on Olive St to US-20. Turn right on SE Benson Rd. Turn left onto Yaquina Bay Rd. Continue onto N Bay Blvd through Toledo. Turn right onto US-20 E approx. 25 miles to Blodgett where we will take a break at the store.

Resume from Blodgett NE on US-20 E back to Albany.

MISSION

This ride is organized with the purpose of recognizing those military Veterans who have served this country with honor and continue to serve their fellow Veterans, above and beyond the call of duty.

SPONSOR

Any recognized Veteran's organization or support organization may sponsor this annual ride. At the closing of each ride a new sponsor will be chosen for the next year's ride. Multiple organizations are encouraged to participate in

order to cover the many Veterans that meet the guidelines set below.

ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES

1. Verified Military, Guard, Active Reserve service. This may be verified by DD-214 or other discharge documents provided; VA registration card; retirement ID card; American Legion membership; VFW membership; VVA membership; AMVETS membership; OVMA membership or other documentation of membership in a recognized veteran's organization. Alternative documentation may be considered on a case by case basis.
2. Verified continued service to fellow veterans verified by membership in the above organizations, Patriot Guard Riders, or other documented service that honors and supports our Veterans and their families. This should be documented by the sponsors for that year's ride.
3. ALR Post 10 will charge a minimum registration fee to cover any costs related to the ride (ie; awards, plaques, meals, etc.) so as not to incur any debt related to the ride or activities. All costs related to the ride are the sole responsibility of ALR Post 10. Any and all funds remaining at the end of the ride are to be disbursed ALR Post 10 to cover the cost of hosting the event.
4. Each Post is encouraged to bring auction items to sell at the event which will be used to offset costs incurred to host the ride, meal and plaques.
5. Each Post is encouraged to nominate at least one (1) veteran to be recognized. The cost of the plaque is \$36.00. If enough money is raised from the auction, a portion or all of the plaque money will be returned.

CRITERIA
